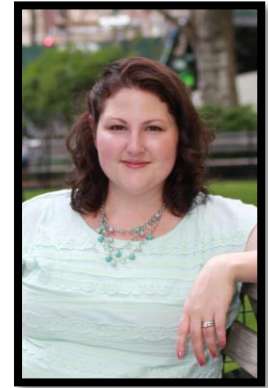

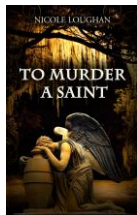

SAINTS MYSTERY SERIES

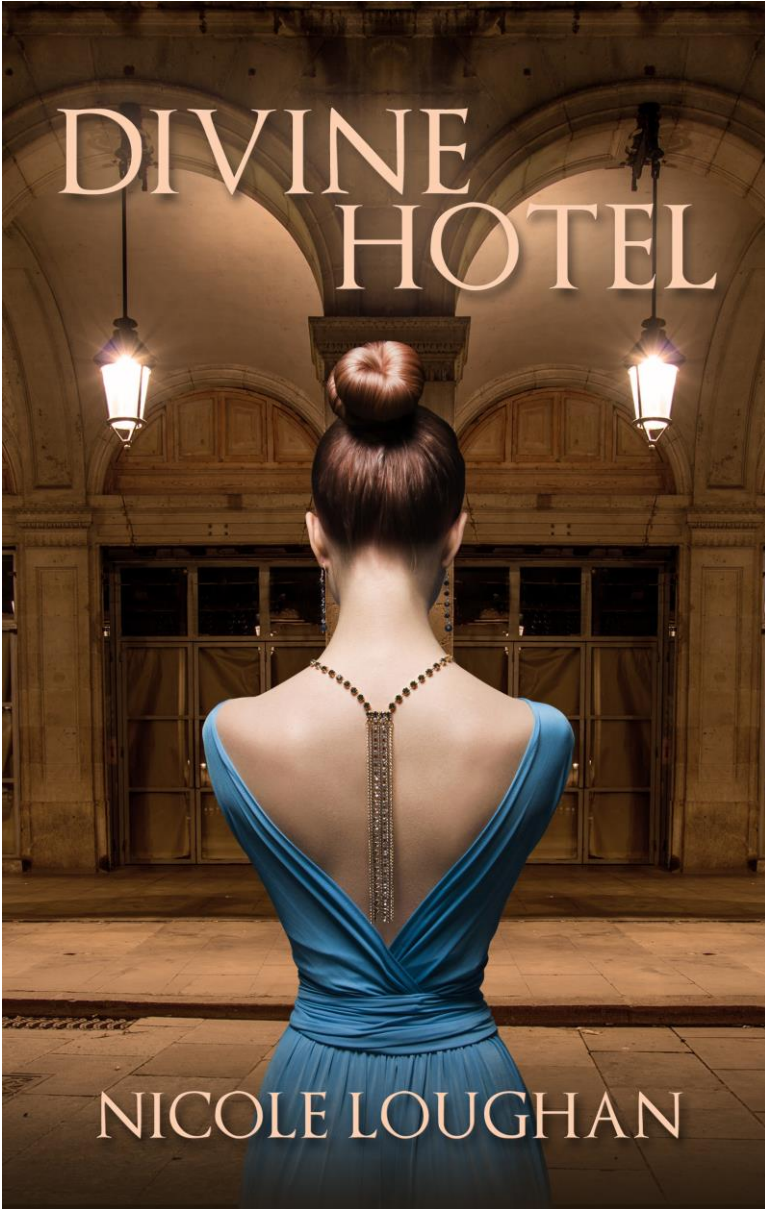
